A quite remarkable wine packed with a full rich flavour. Great weight of fruit balanced with zingy acidity and a long finish. | 3 | £14.50 |

(Argentina)
Fabulous rose and peach aromas while the palate is refreshingly zingy so leaving a lingering but voluptuous aftertaste. | 2 | £15.50 |
| 8. | Currabridge Unwooded Chardonnay
(Australia)
With no oak contact this wine shows very clean ripe peach and melon fruit. | 2 | £16.50 |

(New Zealand)
Classy Sauvignon from a long established family estate. Intense aromas and flavours showing ripe gooseberry fruit with a long, crisp finish. | 1 | £17.95 |
| 12. | Pouilly Fuisse
(Burgundy)
The best white from the Macon region. Made with a cocktail of generous fruit and delicate oak, giving weight, length and complexity. | 2 | £22.95 |

Ripe plum and cherry fruit is evident on the nose and on the palate with vanilla from the subtle use of American oak. | C | £16.50 |
| 16. | Terre al Lago Pinot Nero
(Italy)
This shows how a class winemaker can produce a wine with ripe cherry and red fruit flavours and aromas. | B | £16.50 |
| 17. | El Coto Rioja Crianza
(Spain)
This Rioja Crianza is ruby red, has excellent harmony of fruit, tannin and oak and is renowned for its velvety smooth feel in the mouth. | C | £17.95 |
